Marine parks washington state

Some major landforms in Washington state include the Olympic Mountains and the Cascade Mountains. Other landforms in the state are located in the Columbia Plateau and include Channeled Scablands, Palouse Hills, Yakima Fold Belt and Northern Blue Mountains. The Cascade Mountains run north to south through the central part of Washington State. Volcanoes in the ranges include Mount Baker, Glacier Peak, Mount Adams, Mount Rainier and Mount St. Helens, with the latter two still active. Mount Rainier is also the highest point in the state with an altitude of 14,411 meters above sea level. The Olympic mountains pass through the western part of the Olympic Peninsula. The Olympic Peninsula is also home to the Hoh Rainforest, which is the only temperate rainforest on the U.S. mainland. The Columbia Plateau is a basin along the Cascades built over millions of years of lava flooding. Within the Columbia Plateau is channeled Scablands, an area of hollowed-out basalt bordered by grasslands in Southeast Washington called palouse hills, and ridges of folded layers of rock that run west to east, the Yakima Fold Belt. Within the plateau of Southeast Washington is part of the North Blue Mountains.
